Drugs Control Administration, Telangana, has been maintaining a vigilant stance, actively monitoring and detecting various offences related to spurious drugs, misleading advertisements, quacks, illegal stocking and sale of drugs, and seizing drugs that were falsely manufactured and sold under the guise of 'food products/nutraceuticals'.

In the month of March, 2025, Drugs Control Administration, Telangana, carried out 65 seizures related to various offences involving medicines.

During the raids conducted in March, 2025, the DCA seized stocks worth Rs. 3.03 lakhs.

Drug Control Administration, Telangana, detected several substandard drugs circulating in the State.

In March-2025, the Drug Control Laboratory reported <u>15 Not of</u> <u>Standard Quality (substandard) drugs.</u> The drugs declared as Not of Standard Quality by the Drugs Control Laboratory, DCA, Hyderabad, in March included antibiotics, antiulcer drugs, antihelmintic and antiprotozoal drugs, etc. The samples failed in the tests for assay, dissolution, and description, which may render the medicines ineffective in treating diseases.

1) SEIZURE OF SPURIOUS DRUGS:

Seizure of Spurious Drugs (Counterfeit Versions) 'Montek-LC' Tablets (Montelukast Sodium and Levocetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets), falsely claimed to be manufactured by Sun Pharma Laboratories Ltd.

Based on intelligence gathered by Drugs Control Administration officials, raids were conducted at several dealers in Hyderabad, leading to the detection of Spurious Drugs (Counterfeit Versions) 'Montek-LC' Tablets (Montelukast Sodium and Levocetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets) circulating in the market.

During the raids, Drugs Inspectors detained the stocks and obtained a comparison statement for the suspected batches from the original manufacturer, Sun Pharma Laboratories Ltd., with the original batches. The manufacturer also concluded that the batch of 'Montek-LC' Tablets (Montelukast Sodium and Levocetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets) detained by the Drugs Control Administration were **"Spurious Drugs/Counterfeit Drugs"**.

During the raid conducted on 18th March, 2025 at Sri Nirmala Pharma, H.No: 8-3-60, Second Bazar, Secunderabad, seized a counterfeit version of **'Montek-LC' Tablets** (Montelukast Sodium and Levocetirizine Hydrochloride Tablets), Batch No.: SIE1910A, Mfg. Date: 07/2023, Exp. Date: 12/2025, falsely claimed to be manufactured by Sun Pharma Laboratories Ltd., Plot No.107-108, Namli Block, P.O Ranipool, East- Sikkim.

2) Seizure of Improperly Stored Tetanus Vaccine and Oxytocin Injections in Hyderabad

On 5th March, DCA officials, acting on credible information, raided the premises of **Sri Nandini Pharma** in **Sultan Bazar, Hyderabad**, and found stocks of **thermolabile** (temperature-sensitive) medicines—**Tetanus Vaccine** and **Oxytocin Injections**—stored at room temperature on racks along with other general drugs. Tetanus Vaccine and Oxytocin Injections should be stored in a refrigerator at 2°C to 8°C to maintain their stability and efficacy.

Storage at room temperature causes a loss of potency, and the use of such injections may adversely affect patients' health, as they fail to produce the intended therapeutic effect.

3) Seizure of Expired Drugs and Physician's Samples:

On 6th March 2025, officials of the Drugs Control Administration, acting on credible information, raided a medical shop named D.P.J Medical and General Stores, situated at D. No. 1-58/22, Sriramulapalle, Abbapuram Village, Mulugu Mandal, Mulugu District.

During the raid, DCA officers found 40 varieties of Physician's Samples-Not for Sale and Expired Drugs, including antiulcer drugs, cough and cold formulations, antifungal drugs, etc., stocked alongside saleable drugs on the racks of the medical shop.

Stocking Physician's Samples and Expired Drugs is a violation of the conditions of the drug license and is an offense punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, which may result in imprisonment for up to two years.

DCA seized 50 medicines for making <u>misleading advertisements</u> claiming that they treat various diseases/disorders, in contravention of the Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act, 1954, or Drugs Rules (Schedule J).

The advertisement of medicines for the treatment of diseases and disorders such as diabetes, leucoderma, leprosy, tuberculosis, blood pressure, sterility, rheumatism, kidney stones, disorders of menstrual flow, fever, etc. is prohibited under the Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act, 1954.

Persons who make misleading advertisements regarding drugs for treatment of certain diseases and disorders are punishable under Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act, 1954, with imprisonment which may extend to six months, or with fine, or with both.

6) Seizure of Drugs Falsely Manufactured and Sold as 'Food Products/Nutraceuticals':

During the raids, the DCA seized two drugs that were falsely manufactured and sold as nutraceuticals.

As per the label claim of the products, **Medos-AT Capsules** (Methylcobalamin, Alpha Lipoic Acid, Folic Acid, Vitamin B1 & B6 Capsules) and **Calgro-D3 Tablets** (Calcium and Vitamin D3 tablets) are classified as 'drugs' according to the Drugs and Cosmetics Act.

The said products must be manufactured only under a 'drug license' issued under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act.

The drugs that are falsely manufactured and sold under a food license are not produced in accordance with 'Good Manufacturing Practices' (GMPs) and often fail to meet the quality standards prescribed in the Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP). Such products pose serious risks to patients' health and may have severe implications. Manufacturing and selling 'drugs' without a valid 'drug license' is punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, with imprisonment for up to five years.

7) Raids at Unlicensed Premises/Medical Shops Operating Illegally Without a Drug Licence:

During the raids carried out in the March, the DCA seized a large stock of drugs worth **Rs. 1.23 lakhs** at Unlicensed Premises/Medical Shops operating illegally without a drug licence.

Stocking drugs for sale without a drug licence is punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act with imprisonment of up to five years.

8) Seizures Conducted at Clinics of Quacks/Unauthorized Practitioners:

The details are as follows:

Drugs Control Administration, Telangana conducted raids on clinics operated by quacks and unauthorized practitioners who were practicing medicine without proper qualifications. During these raids, illegally stocked drugs worth Rs. 1.35 lakhs intended for sale were seized at various locations across the state.

During the raids at the following premises, substantial quantities of medicines **stocked for sale without a drug license** were found.

DCA officials detected several **'antibiotics'** viz., Cefixime, Cefpodoxime, Amoxycillin, Ofloxacin, etc. at the clinics during the raids. Indiscriminate sale of antibiotics, by unqualified persons may have disastrous consequences on the health of rural public, including emergence of **'Antimicrobial Resistance'**.

Officials found **'steroids'** viz. Betamethasone Sodium Phosphate, Dexamethasone, Prednisolone etc. at clinics of a quack. Misusing steroids can have serious health consequences, including immune system suppression, hormonal imbalances, muscle and bone weakness, cardiovascular problems, and psychological effects. The indiscriminate use of steroids poses significant risks to public health.

Wholesalers/Dealers who supply medicines to such unqualified persons/unlicensed entities, who are stocking and selling drugs without a drug license, are also punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, and stringent action shall be taken against such Wholesalers/Dealers. Wholesalers/Dealers shall mandatorily ensure that the recipient entities hold a valid drug license before supplying medicines to them.

Stocking drugs for sale without a drug license is punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, with imprisonment for up to five years.

The public may report any suspected manufacturing activity related to drugs, including narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, in residential,

commercial, or industrial areas, as well as any other complaints regarding illegal activities concerning medicines, through the Drugs Control Administration, Telangana Toll-Free Number 1800-599-6969, which is operational from 10:30 am to 5:00 pm on all working days.
