**A) Illegal Stocking and Sale of Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs)
Busted in Goudavelle, Medchal-Malkajgiri District; API Stocks Worth
Rs. 34 Lakhs Seized During Raid.**

**B) In a separate event, the Drugs Control Administration, Telangana,
raided a medical shop at Bheemaram Village, Kethepally Mandal,
Nalgonda District, which was operating illegally without a drug licence.
Drugs worth Rs. 55,000/-, stocked for sale at the unlicensed premises,
were seized during the raid.**

**A) Illegal Stocking and Sale of APIs Busted in Goudavelle, Medchal-
Malkajgiri District**

The details are as follows:

Based on credible intelligence regarding the unauthorized stocking and sale of Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs), officers of the Drugs Control Administration, Telangana, on 17th June, 2026, conducted a raid on the premises of Cocreate Global Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (Scimplify), located at Goudavelle Village, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, and detected **illegal stocking for sale of APIs without a valid drug licence.**

During the raid, DCA officials found and seized **thirty-two (32) HDPE drums** containing bulk drugs/APIs being stocked for sale without a valid licence, in contravention of the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940. The seized stock comprised **thirteen (13) HDPE drums of Itraconazole IP** labelled as manufactured by Spansules Pharma Tech Pvt. Ltd., Achutapuram, Anakapalli District, Andhra Pradesh, and **nineteen (19) HDPE drums of Clopidogrel Bisulphate IP** labelled as manufactured by Aptra Synthesis Pvt. Ltd., Thumakunta Village, Indupur Mandal, Sri Sathya Sai District, Andhra Pradesh.

The stocks were seized from the possession of Vadlamudi Mohan Vamsi Krishna, General Manager, Cocreate Global Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (Scimplify). The total worth of the API stocks seized is **Rs. 34 lakhs**.

Dr. B. Lakshmi Narayana, Assistant Director, Medchal, Smt. B. Mounika, Drugs Inspector, Medchal, Smt. M. Hemalatha, Drugs Inspector, Gandimaisamma, and Dr. R. Geethanjali, Drugs Inspector, Prashanthi Nagar carried out the raid under the supervision of Sri G. Srinivas, Deputy Director-I, DCA.

DCA officers lifted the samples for analysis. Further investigation will be carried out, and action will be taken as per the law against all the offenders.

Engaging in the sale of Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (APIs) without a valid drug license constitutes a violation of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act and is punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to five years.

B) Raid and Seizure of Medicines at an Unlicensed Medical Shop in Bheemaram Village, Kethepally Mandal, Nalgonda District

The details are as follows:

Drugs Control Administration, Telangana officials, acting on credible information regarding the illegal sale of medicines, raided a medical shop located at D. No. 3-07, Bheemaram Village, Kethepally Mandal, Nalgonda District, on 17th June, 2026.

K. Narsaiah was running a medical shop at the said premises illegally, without a drug licence.

During the raid, DCA officers detected the unauthorized stocking of a large quantity of medicines for sale. A total of **31 varieties** of medicines, including antibiotics, antiulcer drugs, analgesics, and other drugs, were found stocked for sale at the premises. The stock, worth **Rs. 55,000/-**, was seized by the officers during the raid.

Sri Ch. Sampath Kumar, Drugs Inspector, Nalgonda and Sri G. Surender, Drugs Inspector, Suryapet, conducted the raid under the supervision of Sri V. Ravi Kumar, Assistant Director, Nalgonda.

DCA officers lifted the samples for analysis. Further investigation shall be carried out and action shall be taken as per the law against all the offenders.

Wholesalers/Dealers who supply medicines to such unlicensed shops, which are stocking and selling drugs without a drug licence, are also punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, and stringent action shall be taken against such Wholesalers/Dealers. Wholesalers/Dealers shall mandatorily ensure that the recipient entities hold a valid drug licence before supplying medicines to them.

Drugs Control Administration, Telangana, issues drug licences for the stocking and selling of medicines in accordance with the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act.

Stocking drugs for sale without a drug licence is punishable under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, with imprisonment for up to five years.

The public may report any complaints regarding illegal activities related to medicines, as well as any other suspected manufacturing activities concerning drugs, including narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances, in residential, commercial, or industrial areas through the **Drugs Control Administration, Telangana Toll-Free Number 1800-599-6969**, operational from 10:30 am to 5:00 pm on all working days.
